Prof. Peter Thomsen is affiliated with the University of Gothenburg, specifically in the field of Biomaterials. He has made significant contributions to the scientific community, particularly in dentistry, and is recognized by experts worldwide. Prof. Thomsen has authored numerous national and international publications and serves as a reviewer for prestigious journals. He is actively involved in various professional societies and academies and has received several awards for his contributions to science. His research primarily focuses on biomaterials and their applications in dentistry.



Dr. Charles S Sfeir Translational Science, Periodontics University of Pittsburgh, USA

Dr. Charles Sfeir is the Associate Dean of Research in the University of Pittsburgh School of Dental Medicine, an Associate Professor in the Clinical and Translational Science Institute, an Associate Professor in the School of Dental Medicine (Departments of Oral Biology and Periodontology) and the School of Engineering (Biomedical Engineering), and the Founding Director of the Center for Craniofacial Regeneration. Dr. Sfeir attended Northwestern University, receiving a Doctor of Dental Surgery degree, a PhD in Molecular Biology and Biochemistry, and an MS in Periodontology. Prior to attending Northwestern University, he received a Doctor of Dental Surgery from the Université Louis Pasteur – Strasbourg, France.

Prof. Faleh Tamimi is a distinguished researcher with a focus on translational research in dentistry, holding academic positions at McGill University, Jordan University, and Qatar University. His work spans biomaterials, tissue regeneration, inflammation, chronobiology, and artificial intelligence in dentistry, emphasizing the practical application of scientific discoveries. With an impressive publication record and numerous accolades, including the Canada Research Chair, Prof. Tamimi contributes significantly to advancing dental research and its clinical implications. Prof. Tamimi attended Jordan University receiving Bachelor of Dental Surgery degree, then received Clinical Master degree in geriatric dentistry and implant prosthodontics, and European PhD in Biomaterials from University of Madrid.



Dr. Jin XiaoTranslational Science, Oral microbiology
University of Rochester, USA

Dr. Jin Xiao, who holds a position of Associate Professor in Oral microbiology and Translational Science at Eastman Institute for Oral Health (EIOH), University of Rochester, focuses on translational research aimed at bridging clinical practice and research, particularly in treating biofilm-related infections. She has published numerous peer-reviewed articles and is recognized for her work with the American Association for Dental Research Hatton-Competition Award. Her current research investigates the virulence and 3D structure of oral and peri-implant biofilms, with the goal of developing innovative treatment strategies.

Dr. Xiao earned her DDS (2003), and PhD in oral microbiology (2009) from West China College of Stomatology, Sichuan University, China. She completed her last two years of PhD study (2007-2009) in the Center of Oral Biology, University of Rochester.

Prof. Paul E. Rossouw Orthodontics University of Rochester, USA

Prof. Rossouw is the chair of the Division of Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics at the Eastman Institute for Oral Health, University of Rochester Medical Center, with a distinguished 40-year career in teaching, research, and clinical care. He has chaired orthodontic departments at the University of North Carolina, Baylor College of Dentistry, and the University of Toronto before joining Eastman in 2015. Prof. Rossouw has authored over 200 publications on clinical orthodontics, biomaterials, and jaw growth, and serves on editorial panels for leading dental journals. He was elected as a director of the American Board of Orthodontics (ABO) and will become its President in May 2026. He is also an active member of several professional organizations, including the AAO, NESO, and the Royal College of Dentists of Canada. Prof. Rossouw completed his BDS, Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics residency and fellowship from University of Stellenbosch (South Africa).



Prof. Sudarat Kiat-amnuay Prosthodontics University of Texas, USA

Prof. Sudarat Kiat-amnuay is a tenured Professor and director of the Advanced Education in General Dentistry (AEGD) Residency Program at UTHealth School of Dentistry at Houston, where she has worked since 2001. Prof. Kiat-amnuay has received over 50 teaching and research awards, published several peer-reviewed articles, and contributed to multiple book chapters. She serves as principal investigator for funded projects, including NIH and HRSA grants, focusing her research on maxillofacial prosthetics, prosthodontics, implant dentistry, and dental biomaterials. She is a diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics and the American Board of Clinical Anaplastology, and a fellow of the American College of Prosthodontists. Prof. Kiat-amnuay attended Khon Kaen University Faculty of Dentistry receiving Doctor of Dental Surgery degree, then received Master degree in Oral Biology, prosthodontics residency certificate from University of Louisville School of Dentistry. She earned a Maxillofacial Prosthetics and Oncologic residency certificate from UT M.D. Anderson Cancer Center. Prof. Kiat-amnuay completed Advanced Education in General Dentistry at UTHealth School of Dentistry at Houston.

His research focuses on applying tissue engineering to achieve functional and esthetic reconstructions in patients with tissue loss due to tumors, trauma, or congenital deformities. He emphasizes interdisciplinary collaborations to develop innovative composite tissue engineering techniques. Dr. Makhoul also leads a CAOMS-funded project to create an oral oncology database, aimed at improving patient outcomes and informing future clinical trials. He received his BSc with distinction from the University of Alberta in Biochemistry and DMD at McGill University. He earned his MD, completed his clinical residency training in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, and fellowship in Maxillofacial Oncology and Microvascular Surgery at the University of Michigan. Dr. Makhoul is a dual-degreed and board-certified Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon specializing in Maxillofacial Oncology and Microvascular Reconstructive Surgery
